Your homework will be graded on the percentage of questions answered correctly as well as some other factors determined by the instructor when he looks at your homework.

Here are some qualities of excellent homework.

- Every page should have your name and the section number at the top.
- Problems should be worked in a single column.
- Problem number should be easily identifiable.
- Answers should be easily identifiable.
- There should be work and not just answers. Note that some problems really are simple enough to have just answers but most are not.
- Some problems can be worked with the calculator programs provided by the instructor. When these are used, identify the information that was entered into the calculator.
- Do not erase anything other than a small mistakes. Mistakes should have a line drawn through them.
- Story problems that need definition statements will have them.
- Story problems need a story answer.
- Proper units should be provided in your answers.
- Columns on tableaus will be labeled. It may be permissible to skip labeling some of the intermediate tableaus.
