Mathematics Truth Project

- 1. True False 2 + 3 = 5
- 2. Why do you know your answer to question number 1 is accurate? Explain thoroughly.
- 3. If you were explaining your answer to an individual who did not know mathematics, how would your answer be explained? Be thorough in your explanation.
- 4. What is truth?

This is a very complex question. It will require research on the student's part. Not showing any research shows a lack of effort in examining the project.

General notes on papers:

- 1. All projects are to have a properly prepared cover page.
- 2. All projects are to have a bibliography page done correctly.
- 3. All papers are to be typed.
- 4. Use Times New Roman 12 point font for the paper.
- 5. All papers stapled in upper left hand corner.
- 6. Proper English is to be used. Incorrect use will result in a lower grade.
- 7. Misspellings will result in significant lower grade.
- 8. The paper needs to be thorough enough to cover the subject. For example, above question 4 will require a minimum of at least one full page and 2 would be much better.
